Successful applicants are notified of the committee's decision by May 30 of each year. All decisions of the selection committee are final. You will receive up to \$4,000 per academic year for educational and living expenses for two to four years. To receive the full amount for all years of study, you must attend an accredited post-secondary institution, remain in the program of study under which the scholarship was awarded and maintain a full time status and good academic standing. RBC requests confirmation of your full course load and good academic standing at the beginning of every fall and winter semester. Confirmation must be in a format satisfactory to RBC. You will receive the first half of your scholarship at the beginning of the fall semester. If you maintain good academic standing, you will receive the balance of the scholarship in January. Please note: RBC reserves the right to change or discontinue this program at any time. If the program changes or ends, we will honour commitments already in place.
